### NHRC suggestions for the implementation of fundamental rights

The Commission has concluded separate discussions on the topic “the role of the parliament and the government for the implementation of the fundamental rights” focusing on the fundamental rights enshrined in the Constitution of Nepal with around 850 persons, including ministers of the federal government; chief ministers and ministers of provincial governments, speaker and deputy speaker, members of provincial assemblies, human rights activists, civil society and representatives from professional organisations in Kathmandu and headquarters of seven different provinces marking the 70th anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. The stakeholders had expressed their common commitments on the implementation of the fundamental rights enshrined in the Constitution. On the basis of the stakeholders’ common commitment and the suggestions received at the end of the programs, it shows that the legislature, the executive and the civil society have to play role for the implementation of the fundamental rights. In accordance with the Commission’s decision on September 12, 2019, for the implementation of the fundamental rights following suggestions have been forwarded to the Law, Justice and Human rights Committee under the House of Representatives, and the seven different provincial assembly.

#### Suggestions:

1. To create conducive environment to formulate human rights friendly laws form the Legislature;
2. Make necessary effort to solve the problem generated due to lack of timely enactment of the laws that had to be enacted by the Federal level as it also created a kind of confusion in the Local and Provincial level;
3. To provide essential suggestions and advice to the government reviewing their progress report on the implementation of fundamental rights;

4. To provide directive order to the government to bring to book the perpetrators and provide justice to the victims reprimanding the state on the violation of human rights;
5. To make an effort to formulate the essential laws related to the implementation of the economic, social and cultural rights with urgency and priority;
6. To provide advice and suggestions to the government to formulate human rights friendly policies and activities;
7. To provide direction to ensure principle of inclusion and proportional representation in all types of appointments;
8. To create conducive environment of massive participation of the National Human Rights Commission and other concerned agencies while formulating the laws related to the implementation of fundamental rights and other issues of human rights.
