The office building of the Commission completely damaged, the daily office work resumed in temporary office

The Commission expresses its deep sorrow over the loss of human and crisis invited by massive earthquake that hit the country on April 25 and 26, 2015. The earthquake has caused the irreparable loss of human lives and rendered millions of people homeless in many parts of the country. The Commission has urged all the people to take shelter in secured place and to have patience while the country is passing through the unprecedented national crisis.

Similarly, the Commission urges the government and private sector doctors, health workers and volunteers to extend their helping hand in providing treatment from their own sector to the injured sustained due to tremor.

Enduring the crisis as such, the first and foremost priority at this hour is to provide treatment and relief to the victims of the massive earthquake.

The Commissions, therefore, calls upon the Government of Nepal, international community, social organizations and agencies, volunteers, human rights defenders and civil society to come forward to rescue those injured and killed in the massive earthquake and to effectively distribute the relief materials to the victims.

The Commission would also like to draw the attention of the Government for the appropriate management and protection of the millions of citizens languishing under the open sky due to the fear of earthquake.

Monitoring on the crisis management

The Office building of the Commission has been completely damaged due to the massive earthquake that hit the country on 25th and 2th April, 2015. The temporary office has been set up outside the office of the Commission and resumed the daily office works. Similarly, the Commission has commenced special monitoring on the crisis management activities following the occurrence of the natural disaster in the country.
